The High Performance Committee led by June Voukolos, have a critical role to play including contributing to a 3 year High Performance Strategic plan. The committee will review current programs in place such as the State Based Training Program, establish the criteria around a National Training Squad, further develop and refine the pathways through the sport and establish Talent ID programs. The committee importantly reflects a good mix of stakeholders including elite athletes, coaches and administrators.

The technical committee requires an extremely specialist knowledge of the technical elements of the sport including lane conditioning, ball drilling and lane measurement for WTBA conformance.
