TBA New Coach Registration is valid for two (2) years. Renewals after this period are similarly two (2) year periods. Certified coaching hours and updating certificates must accompany renewal applications. Coaching registrations periods are from 1st July through to 30th June.

Fees

Please note that the Accreditation Program Fee for Level One can range from \$175-\$250 and for Level Two can range from \$300-\$500. State/Territory Program providers may need to charge a higher fee to cover the cost of the venue, facilitator, other costs associated with the program or if the program has less than 10 candidates. This fee can be no more than \$250 per participant for Level One or \$500 per participant for Level Two and will be charged by the State/Territory.

Child Protection

- the individual has not committed an offence involving sexual activity or acts of indecency which is or was punishable by penal servitude or imprisonment for 12 months or more in any State in Australia, or an offence committed elsewhere that would have been punishable by penal servitude or imprisonment for 12 months or more if it had been committed in Australia.
- the individual is suitable by virtue of character and previous history to be entrusted with the care of young people participating in the sport of Tenpin Bowling.
