RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

RULES - All TBA Tournament Rules and Regulations will apply. Tournament Accreditation Number A10/0084. All rules apply to Seniors Championships and the Adult Championships.

CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS - The Championships will incorporate the National Seniors Championships. Seniors may enter the Adult, Seniors or both Championships, with the proviso that each individual entry will identify which Championship the bowler wishes to use that entry in.

SENIORS CHAMPIONSHIP - Doubles and Teams entries in this Championship must comprise entirely of Senior bowlers. Seniors must attain the age of 50 or above in the year of the competition and must tick the relevant square on the Participation Registration Form to define whether the entry is in the Seniors Championship or the Adult National Championships. No ticks will mean Adult entry.

ELIGIBILITY - This tournament is open to all TBA Registered Players in good standing and who have attained the age of 18 years or above prior to participating in the Championship. Current TBA membership Cards must be presented at check-in.

NO REFUND AFTER ENTRIES CLOSE - Teams or Individuals who do not bowl in their allocated squads will not be entitled to claim a refund. Teams or Individuals who are unable to bowl in their event, can sell their spot to another competitor. Whilst the Tournament Committee will help where possible to reschedule entries, it is not the responsibility of the Tournament committee to sell or recover money for unused entries.

DRESS CODE - Bowler's must wear neat acceptable attire. Men to preferably wear dress slacks, no shorts. Ladies may wear dress shorts, skirts, 3/4 pants or skorts. No jeans, T shirts, tank tops, or hats are to be worn whilst competing.

ENTERING AVERAGES - Each bowler must use their highest current league average as at the 30th June 2010 which has been established over a minimum of 18 games in a League or Accredited Tournament Organisation.

GRADINGS - Based on averages submitted, entries will be Graded in accordance with the Australian Adult Championship Gradings Table.

BOWLERS WITHOUT AN AVERAGE - Any bowler without an average as described may apply to TBA for classification prior to submitting an entry. If no such application is received, then an entering average of 200 for Men and 190 for Women will apply.

Note: Any bowler may enter in OPEN Grade.

AVERAGE REVIEW - The Tournament Director reserves the right to review the average and regrade any bowler at any time. Participation using an incorrect average may result in disqualification.

REPLACEMENTS - Any change from the original Entry or line-up must be reported to the Tournament Room prior to the scheduled starting time.

GAMES TO BE PLAYED - In each Grade a three (3) game series will be played in 5 Man Teams, Doubles and Singles.

MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION -

TEAMS - All teams are 5 person teams. Bowlers may have unlimited entries with the same or different partners or combinations.

DOUBLES - Bowlers may have unlimited entries with the same or different partner.

SINGLES - Bowlers may have unlimited entries in their grade or any grade above their own classification.

ALL EVENTS - An All Events Champion will be declared for each average classification for which paid entries are received. Scores from each bowler's BEST appearance in Teams, Doubles and Singles will count towards their All Events total. Scores in the Mixed Doubles and Mixed Teams will count towards All Events. Entering average will determine All Events classification, unless application is received to upgrade a bowlers All Events entry.

Eligibility is subject to the payment of the **\$6.00 ALL EVENTS FEE**. This Fee must be paid BEFORE bowling in their first Event. Participants can enter both the Championships All Events and the Seniors All Events. Either All Events will be accepted to satisfy eligibility into any event requiring an All Events entry. Only Championships events will be counted in Championships All Events and only Seniors events will be counted in the Seniors Championships All Events.

PRIZE FUND - Trophies, medallions, shirts, awards and any other prizes for the Championships will be purchased from the total prize fund received. The same will apply to the All Events prize money received. The Championships and All Events prize funds distributed in cash or cheque will be the balance remaining after purchases have been made and will be paid in the ratio of one (1) prize for every ten (10) entries in the Championships and one (1) prize for every twenty (20) entries in All Events.

NOTE - Any matters arising which are not covered by these Tournament Rules will be determined by the TBA Tournament Committee.

SMOKING and CONSUMPTION of ALCOHOL will be prohibited during a session of continuous games.

MOBILE PHONES - Competitors mobile phones must be turned off while competing in an event.

EVENT QUALIFYING - \$10.00 qualifying fees for RESTRICTED CUP, SENIORS CUP, CLASSIC CUP and \$15.00 qualifying fees for the AMF AUSTRALIAN MASTERS are to be paid in the Tournament Room prior to the relevant singles or doubles squad being used for qualifying. No pre paid qualifying fees will be accepted prior to the event.

TBA SENIORS CUP - Open to all Male and Female bowlers who must attain the age of 50 years or above in the year of the competition. Qualifying in any 3 game Singles or Doubles event within the Championship. All finalists must have completed an All Events entry in the Championship. Finalists must check in by 1.30pm on Monday 18th October for a 2.00pm start. Refer to TBA Seniors Cup Tournament details for further information.

TBA CLASSIC CUP - Qualifying in any 3 game Singles or Doubles event. All finalists must have completed an All Events entry in the Championship. Finalists must check in by 1.30pm on Monday 25th October for a 2.00pm start. Refer to TBA Classic Cup Tournament details for further information.

TBA GRAND SENIORS - Refer to TBA Grand Seniors Section for further information.

NATIONAL SENIORS TEAM CHALLENGE - The schedule begins on Tuesday 19th October. Refer to the National Seniors Team Challenge Rules on the TBA web site.

TBA SENIORS CUP

ELIGIBILITY - This tournament is open to all TBA Registered Players who must attain the age of 50 years or above in the year of the competition. Proof of age may be requested. To be eligible to compete in the final, all bowlers (including the Defending Champions) must have completed an "All Events" entry in the Championship.

FORMAT - This is a scratch event conducted in two stages with separate divisions for Men and Women.

Stage 1 Qualifying - Qualifying will be the highest three (3) game singles or doubles attempt bowled during the Championship. Qualifying will cease on completion of the 11.00am squad on Monday 18th October. Any three (3) game singles or doubles attempt used for Seniors Cup qualifying will incur an additional fee of \$10.00 (Ten dollars) which must be paid in the Tournament Room prior to the squad in which the bowler is participating. This applies to State/Territory Seniors champions as well.

Stage 2 Final - 24 Men and 24 Women qualifiers will compete in the final. The final field will be made up of the Defending Seniors Cup Champions, the various State/Territory Seniors champions and the balance based on the highest placed Men and Women qualifiers according to their qualifying score. In the event of a tie for the final qualifying position, a single game will be played to break the tie. Highest pinfall will decide. Any subsequent tie will require a 10th frame playoff until the tie is broken.

Finalists will bowl 8 games, with a lane change after each game, scratch pinfall to count. The field will then be cut to the top eight (8) with pinfall carrying over. The top eight will then play seven (7) games of head to head with 20 bonus points for a win and 10 bonus points for a draw. Total pinfall plus bonus points will determine the overall winners. In the event of a tie, a single game will be played to break the tie. Highest pinfall will decide. Any subsequent tie will require a 10th frame playoff until the tie is broken. A tie for second or third will be decided by high game in Matchplay. If still tied, second highest game and so on.

TBA GRAND SENIORS SECTION

ELIGIBILITY - Open to all TBA Registered Players who will attain the age of 60 years or above in the year of the competition. Proof of age may be requested.

FORMAT - At the completion of the first 8 games bowled in Stage 2 of the Seniors Cup, the top three eligible male and female bowlers will be awarded first, second and third placed Grand Seniors.

Any ties will be decided on highest Stage 2 game. If a tie still exists, then second highest game will be used and so on.

Eligibility - This is a scratch event which is open to all TBA adult Silver members. To be eligible to compete in the final, every bowler (including the Defending and State/Territory Champions) must have lodged and completed an "All Events" entry in the Championship and lodged at least two qualifying attempts. There will be a male and female division and all rules apply to both divisions.

Qualifying - Qualifying will be over 6 games, using the highest two x three (3) game singles or doubles attempts bowled during the 2010 Adult National Championships until completion of the 12.00pm squad on Friday 29th October. Any Singles or Doubles attempt used for qualifying will cost \$35 and incur an additional qualifying fee of \$15.00 (Fifteen dollars) which must be paid in the Tournament Room immediately prior to the squad in which the bowler is participating. This applies to Defending Champion and State/Territory Champions as well. Maximum of 40 qualifiers per Division will compete in the final. The Defending Champion and the State/Territory Masters winners cannot be eliminated from Qualifying.

Seedings - All bowlers will be seeded for Round One of the Finals from the total of their two best 3 game qualifying scores from the TBA National Championships. No pinfall will carry over in any of the Final Rounds.

Ties - In the event of a tie for 4th, 16th or 40th qualifying positions, 12th position after Rounds 1 or 2, 8th position after Round 3, or any match in Rounds 4 to 6, a one game playoff will be played, scratch pinfall to decide the winner. If the tie continues, a 9th and 10th frame will be bowled until the tie is broken.

For TBA Ranking points, a tie between any bowlers who have been eliminated in Rounds 1 to 3 will be decided by the highest last game in the last 6 game block. If the tie still exists, the highest second to last game will be used and so on until the tie is broken.

Final – Round 1

Bowlers seeded positions 1 through 4 will receive a double round bye to Round 3. Bowlers seeded positions 5 through 16 will receive a single round bye to Round 2. Bowlers filling qualifying positions 17 through 40 will bowl 6 games scratch, changing lanes after each game, evens two lanes to the right, odd 2 lanes to the left. One male and one female per lane. The top 12 bowlers on total pinfall move into Round 2. The bottom 12 bowlers are eliminated and will receive prize payouts for positions 29th to 40th.

Final – Round 2

Bowlers seeded positions 5 through 16 will join the top 12 bowlers from Round 1. These 24 bowlers will then play 6 games scratch, changing lanes after each game, evens two lanes to the right, odd 2 lanes to the left. The top 12 bowlers on total pinfall move into Round 3. The bottom 12 bowlers in each are eliminated and will receive prize payouts for positions 17th to 28th.

Final – Round 3

Bowlers seeded positions 1 through 4 will join the top 12 bowlers from Round 2. These 16 bowlers will then play 6 games scratch, changing lanes after each game, evens two lanes to the right, odd 2 lanes to the left. . The top 8 bowlers on total pinfall move into Round 4. The bottom 8 bowlers are eliminated and will receive prize payouts for positions 9th to 16th.

Final – Round 4

The top 8 bowlers from Round 3 will compete in a single elimination format as shown in the finals chart, seeded by their Round 3 pinfall. Each match will be the best of 5 games (first to win 3 games). The winning 4 bowlers will move into Round 5. The losing 4 bowlers are eliminated and will receive prize payouts for positions 5th to 8th.

Final – Round 5

Winners from Round 4 will compete in a single elimination format. Each match will be the best of 5 games (first to win 3 games). The winning 2 bowlers will move into Round 6. The losing 2 bowlers are eliminated and will receive prize payouts for positions 3rd and 4th.

Final – Round 6

Winners from Round 5 will compete in a single elimination format. Each match will be the best of 5 games (first to win 3 games). The Winners will be declared the 2010 AMF Australian Masters Champions and receive the winners trophies. First, Second and Third will receive Gold, Silver and Bronze medallions respectively. The winners will also get free entry into the 2011 event.

Check-in Times Final

Friday 29th: Check-in by 2.30pm. ALL Bowlers including those receiving bye(s). All finalists will be introduced and receive a finalists medallion.

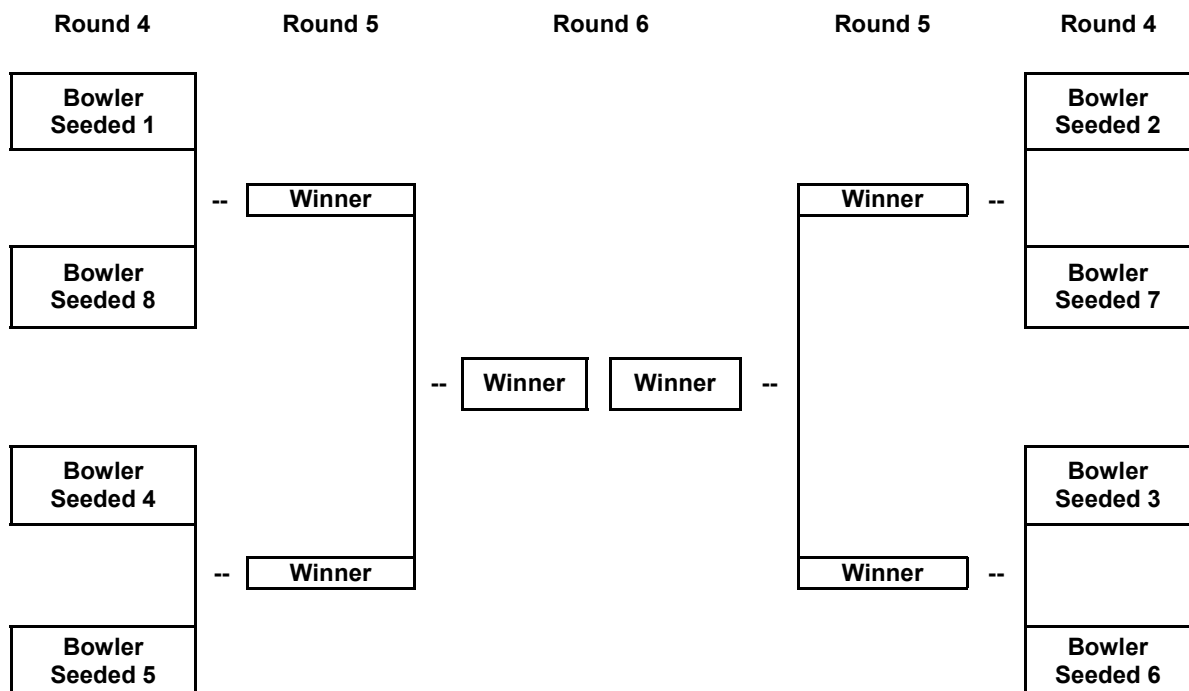
Saturday 30th: Lanes on at 8.55am for warm-up. Round 3 commences at 9.00am

If a player fails to check-in for the Finals, the highest available non-qualifier will be invited to replace the absent player. The replacement bowler will be added into the final in seeding order based on qualifying score. Once the Finals start, no further replacements will be permitted. Non-appearance will result in forfeiture of the games missed. From the completion of Round 3, non-appearance will result in the player present bowling without opposition, and advancing to the next round.

Finals Entry Fees

Fees for Finalists will be \$200.00 per Qualifier. The Defending Champions have a free entry.
