RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

RULES - All TBA Tournament Rules and Regulations will apply. Accreditation Numbers Tournament : A10/0009 State Teams Challenge: A10/0009

ELIGIBILITY - This tournament is open to all TBA Registered Players in good standing who meet the requirements of a bowler with a disability under TBA rules on or prior to the first day of the Championship.

DRESS CODE - Bowler's must wear neat acceptable attire. No jeans, T shirts, tank tops or hats are to be worn whilst competing.

ENTERING AVERAGES - Each bowler must use their highest current league average as at the 19th March, 2010 which has been established over a minimum of 18 games. During league in a TBA Registered centre If bowlers have more than 18 Games then the average is taken over the entire league . League History to be attached with entry form. Must be an authorized print out from the Bowling Centre scoring system.

GRADINGS - Based on averages submitted, entries will be Graded in accordance with the Australian Disability Championship Gradings Table.

BOWLERS WITHOUT AN AVERAGE - Any bowler without an average as described, may apply to TBA for grading prior to submitting an entry. If no such application is received, then an entering average of 180 for Men and 170 for Women will apply.

Note: Any bowler may enter in OPEN Grade.

AVERAGE REVIEW - The Tournament Director reserves the right to review the average and regrade any bowler at any time. Participation using an incorrect average may result in disqualification.

REPLACEMENTS - Any change from the original Entry or line-up must be reported to the Tournament Room prior to the scheduled starting time.

GAMES TO BE PLAYED - In each Grade a three (3) game series will be played in Teams, Doubles and Singles.

MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION - TEAMS - In team events at least one partner must be changed. Bowlers may have a maximum of 4 entries.

DOUBLES - Bowlers may have 4 entries maximum which must be with a different partner.

SINGLES - Bowlers may have 4 entries maximum 2 in their own grade and 2 in any grade above their own.

ALL EVENTS - An All Events Champion will be declared for each grade in which paid entries are received. Scores from each bowler's first Teams, Doubles and Singles will count towards their All Events total. Eligibility is subject to the payment of the **\$6.00 ALL**

EVENTS FEE. This Fee must be paid BEFORE bowling in the Australian Disability Championships.

AWARDS: Medals will be presented for 1st, 2nd & 3rd places in all grades for Singles, Doubles, Teams & All Events. Additionally, Trophies will be presented for the Highest Game overall (Male & Female), Highest Series overall (Male & Female) and Highest Pins over average overall (Male and Female) based on bowlers all events score. NOTE - Any matters arising which are not covered by these Tournament Rules will be determined by the TBA Disabilities Tournament Committee.

SMOKING and CONSUMPTION of ALCOHOL will be prohibited during a session of continuous games. Contravening this rule will incur penalties defined in the TBA Code of Conduct.

MOBILE PHONES Competitors mobile phones must be turned off while competing in an event.

CODE OF CONDUCT: Tenpin Bowling Australia's Code of conduct will apply to this tournament.

STATE TEAM CHALLENGE (Scratch) 2010
Rules - Regulations - Requirements

1. These Rules will apply for the conduct and control of the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge and related matters.
2. The TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge was established by the TBA Disabilities Committee in response to the wishes of bowlers with disabilities and their carers following requests for increased options and for furthering their bowling careers.

3. **NAME**

The Tournament will be known as the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge (Scratch).

4. **PURPOSE**

The purpose of the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge is to determine annually the best State/Territory each consisting of eight players in the team.

To foster, develop and advance a spirit of good sportsmanship and fellowship, to promote and maintain a good relationships amongst the representative teams and to advance their mutual interest in relation to bowling and identify talent for selection Into Development Squads and also Australian representative teams.

5. **STATES/TERRITORIES TO BE REPRESENTED**

Participation in the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge will be limited to one team from the following States and Territories:-

- a. Queensland
- b. New South Wales
- c. Victoria
- d. Tasmania
- e. South Australia
- f. Western Australia
- g. Australian Capital Territory
- h. Northern Territory

6. ELIGIBILITY - TEAM MEMBER

Each person:

- (a) Must be a **REGISTERED PLAYER** of Tenpin Bowling Australia in good standing.
- (b) Must be capable of conducting themselves in such a manner so as not to reflect discredit on the Sport, the State/Territory they are representing.
- (c) Must have qualified for Team Membership in accordance with the conditions set down by Tenpin Bowling Australia in section 7.

Each competitor:

- (d) Must have bowled a minimum of 24 games in a League within a TBA Accredited Centre .
- (e) Must meet the eligibility criteria as stated in the Rules of Tenpin Bowling Australia.
- (f) Must have an All Events entry in the TBA Australian Disabilities Championships of that year (ie. bowl in singles, doubles and teams).
- (g) Must have completed an All Events entry in the Championships prior to participation in the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge.

Coaches:

All applicants for the position of Coach of a State/Territory /Zone must hold at least a current level 2 Accreditation under the TBA National Coaching Accreditation Scheme. If none are available or there are insufficient level 2 or higher coaches applying, then the State/Territory /Zone must apply to TBA for a suitable coach to be selected from the coaches' draft.

Selectors:

Parents or relatives (including de facto) of bowlers who have an application for Team selection will not be permitted to serve in any way whatsoever on a selection committee for the Disability State Team Challenge, nor will it be acceptable for them to exercise any degree of influence on any such committee or member of the committee.

7. SELECTION OF TEAMS

- (a) **Teams will be selected by the appropriate 'Disabilities Committee' of their respective State/Territory Association.**
The manner of selection of the state teams will be on scratch results during the State or Territory Championships or role off 2009/2010
- (b) The roster of players for each team in the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge may not exceed eight (8) players. The actual playing strength/line-up for any match will be five (5) players drawn from the roster submitted. All players must participate in at least 1 round, except in cases of emergency as described.

- (c) Each State/Territory Disability Committee must advise the Tournament Director not less than thirty (30) days prior to the commencement of the TBA Australian Disability State Team Challenge of the names and details of their Team Members. (Failure to provide this information by the prescribed time may result in a forfeit by that State/Territory.)

8. BOWLING FEES

Each State/Territory Disability Committee will be responsible for the payment of the bowling fees (cost of games) associated with the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge. Payment of the entry fee of \$350 is to be made to the Ten-pin Bowling Australia by the date on the entry form.

9. VENUE

The annual TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge will be conducted in the principal centre used for the conduct of the TBA Australian Disabilities Championships, and will take place on the second last day of the Championships.

10. CONTROL OF MATCHES

The Principal Tournament Director will be responsible for all Tournament preparations, and conduct of the matches whilst in progress. The appointed Tournament Director may appoint/engage such assistance as deemed necessary to ensure the successful conduct of the Tournament.

13. FORMAT FOR MATCHES

- (a) Teams will be opposed against each other for one complete round of matches over such time as may be considered necessary, according to the number of participating teams. Each match will be one full team game, and in the event of two or more teams not being represented, the number of matches will be determined by the Tournament Director.
- (b) In the event that an odd number of States/Territories are represented, the team without an opponent on each round will be given maximum point.
- (c) Each State/Territory Disability Committee must advise the Tournament Director not less than thirty (60) days prior to the commencement of the TBA Australian Disability State Team Challenge of the names and details of their Team Members
- (d) In the event that one or more of the nominated team members are unable to bowl, due to an emergency occurrence prior to the commencement of, or during the actual Tournament, such that five (5) players are not available to play, the team will be filled by such eligible bowlers as are necessary, provided that they were part of the Disabilities Committee. Verification by the State/Territory of the bowler's eligibility will be required. The decision as to what constitutes an emergency, will be determined by the Tournament Director.

14. POINTS SYSTEM

Points will be awarded as follows:

- (a) Each team member will be matched against the opposing team member in the corresponding position in the line-up and the bowler achieving the highest total pinfall for the game will win one (1) point for the Team. In the event of an equal game score, the point will be equally shared.

The team's total pinfall will be compared with the total pinfall of the opposing team and two (2) points will be awarded to the team with the highest total pinfall.

In the event of an equal team score, the points will be equally shared.

At the conclusion of the rounds of matches, the team having the highest number of points will be declared the TBA Australian Championships State/Territory Champion for the year.

In the event of two or more teams having the same number of points, Managers will select 5 bowlers each who will play a 9-10 tiebreaker. Each bowler will bowl 2 frames according to their placing on the roster provided to the Tournament Director.

The TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge Trophy is a perpetual trophy and will remain in the custody of the Champion State/Territory to be displayed in the various bowling centres and offices throughout the State/Territory until the commencement of the next Tournament.

Any other matter that may arise during the course of the Tournament that is not covered in the above mentioned Rules and Regulations will be resolved by the Tournament Committee and/or the Tournament Director as deemed appropriate.

All members of the State Teams including Bowlers, Coaching Staff, Management and provided for in Rule 13 (d). and or carers/assistants are to refrain from the consumption of alcohol beverages during the Tournament. Any person found Under the influence of alcohol or consuming alcohol during the Tournament will be withdrawn from the competition immediately.

Rules - Regulations - Requirements

1. These Rules will apply for the conduct and control of the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge and related matters.
2. The TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge was established by the TBA Disabilities Committee in response to the wishes of bowlers with disabilities and their carers following requests for increased options and for furthering their bowling careers.

3. **NAME**

The Tournament will be known as the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge (Handicap).

4. **PURPOSE**

The purpose of the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge is to determine annually the best State/Territory each consisting of eight players in the team.

(b) To foster, develop and advance a spirit of good sportsmanship and fellowship, to promote and maintain a good relationship amongst the representative teams and to advance their mutual interest in relation to bowling and identify talent for selection Into Development Squads and also Australian representative teams.

5. **STATES/TERRITORIES TO BE REPRESENTED**

Participation in the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge will be limited to one team from the following States and Territories:-

- a. Queensland
- b. New South Wales
- c. Victoria
- d. Tasmania
- e. South Australia
- f. Western Australia
- g. Australian Capital Territory
- h. Northern Territory

6. ELIGIBILITY - TEAM MEMBER

Each person:

- (a) Must be a **REGISTERED PLAYER** of Tenpin Bowling Australia in good standing.
- (b) Must be capable of conducting themselves in such a manner so as not to reflect discredit on the Sport, the State/Territory they are representing.
- (c) Must have qualified for Team Membership in accordance with the conditions set down by Tenpin Bowling Australia in section 7.

Each competitor:

- (d) Must have bowled a minimum of 24 games in a league within a TBA Accredited Centre.
- (e) Must meet the eligibility criteria as stated in the Rules of Tenpin Bowling Australia.
- (f) Must have an All Events entry in the TBA Australian Disabilities Championships of that year (ie. bowl in singles, doubles and teams).
- (g) Must have completed an All Events entry in the Championships prior to Participation in the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge.

Coaches:

All applicants for the position of Coach of a State/Territory /Zone must hold at least a current level 2 Accreditation under the TBA National Coaching Accreditation Scheme. If none are available or there are insufficient level 2 or higher coaches applying, then the State/Territory /Zone must apply to TBA for a suitable coach to be selected from the coaches' draft.

Selectors:

Parents or relatives (including de facto) of bowlers who have an application for Team selection will not be permitted to serve in any way whatsoever on a selection committee for the Disability State Team Challenge, nor will it be acceptable for them to exercise any degree of influence on any such committee or member of the committee.

7. SELECTION OF TEAMS

- (a) Teams will be selected by the appropriate 'Disabilities Committee' of their respective State/Territory Associations. The manner of selection of the state teams will be on handicap results in the State Championships or roll off organised by the State Committee for any State Squad or of 2009/2010 on the all events winners of the respective Championships or roll off including handicap.
- (b) Handicap will be 100% of the difference between the players individual average and a base figure of 200.
- (c) The roster of players for each team in the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge (handicap) may not exceed eight (8) players. The actual playing strength/line-up for any match will be five (5) players drawn from the roster

- (c) Each State/Territory Disability Committee must advise the Tournament Director not less than thirty (30) days prior to the commencement of the TBA Australian Disability State Team Challenge of the names and details of their Team Members. (Failure to provide this information by the prescribed time may result in a forfeit by that State/Territory.)

8. BOWLING FEES

Each State/Territory Disability Committee will be responsible for the payment of the bowling fees (cost of games) associated with the TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge. Payment of the entry fee of \$350 is to be made to the Tenpin Bowling Australia by the date on the entry form.

9. VENUE

The annual TBA Australian Disability Championships State Team Challenge will be conducted in the principal centre used for the conduct of the TBA Australian Disabilities Championships, and will take place on the second last day of the Championships.

10. CONTROL OF MATCHES

The Principal Tournament Director will be responsible for all Tournament preparations, and conduct of the matches whilst in progress. The appointed Tournament Director may appoint/engage such assistance as deemed necessary to ensure the successful conduct of the Tournament.

13. FORMAT FOR MATCHES

- (a) Teams will be opposed against each other for one complete round of matches over such time as may be considered necessary, according to the number of participating teams. Each match will be one full team game, and in the event of two or more teams not being represented, the number of matches will be determined by the Tournament Director.
- (b) In the event that an odd number of States/Territories are represented, the team without an opponent on each round will be given maximum point.
- (c) Each State/Territory Disability Committee must advise the Tournament Director not less than thirty (30) days prior to the commencement of the TBA Australian Disability State Team Challenge of the names and details of their Team Members
- (d) In the event that one or more of the nominated team members are unable to bowl, due to an emergency occurrence prior to the commencement of, or during the actual Tournament, such that five (5) players are not available to play, the team will be filled by such eligible bowlers as are necessary, provided that they were part of the State Disabilities Roll Offs.
