## SA UNDER 25'S CHALLENGE TOURNAMENT RULES & CONDITIONS



### **RULES**

These rules shall apply for the conduct and control of the "SA Under 25's Challenge Tournament", and as the tournament is accredited with TBAL all TBAL rules, regulations and Code of Conduct will apply

### **PURPOSE**

To determine annually the Centre / Association with the best-combined representative teams of Under 25 Male and Female bowlers consisting of 4 male and 4 female bowlers. To foster, develop and advance a spirit of good sportsmanship and fellowship, to promote and maintain a good relationship amongst the representative teams and to advance their mutual interest in relation to bowling generally.

### **ASSOCIATIONS / CENTRES REPRESENTED**

Participation in the SA Under 25's Team Challenge will be limited to: One team of four (4) males plus a reserve and one team of four (4) females plus a reserve representing the following Centre / Associations;  
Barossa – Cross Road – Elizabeth - Ingle Farm – Marion – Mount Gambier – Murray Bridge – Noarlunga – Norwood – Port Pirie – Salisbury – Village - Woodville – Whyalla

### **ELIGIBILITY**

- Team members, selectors, coaches and managers must be financial members of Tenpin Bowling Australia and a member of their local centre association in good standing in the year of competition.
- Must be capable of conducting themselves in such a manner so as not to discredit Tenpin Bowling Australia, Tenpin SA or the local Association which they represent.
- Must have competed in at least 18 games prior to the start of the tournament in a league in the centre they wish to represent. League games completed as pre or post bowling do not count towards the number of games bowled.
- Must not have reached twenty five (25) years of age on the first of January in the year of the competition.

### **SELECTION OF TEAMS**

- Centres must advertise for bowlers to represent the centre in the tournament, as the draft eligibility rule requires bowlers seeking to enter the draft to have registered to represent their centre in the first instance.
- Teams shall be selected by the respective Centre / Association. The manner of selecting teams and determining the eligibility is the sole responsibility of each respective Association, although if you have more than 4 applications you are encouraged to conduct a rolloff for selection
- Each centre is restricted to a maximum of 4 male bowlers plus a reserve and 4 female bowlers plus a reserve.
- Nominations may not close nor may roll-offs commence prior to the first day of January and must be completed before the 1<sup>st</sup> of September in the year of the competition.
- In the event that a Centre association has only the required number or less than the required number of players nominated for a team at the closing date for nominations, no rollofts are required
- In that case, the organising committee can decide whether to try and fill the team by applying for the required players through the Draft process, (see attached guidelines), Centre associations are asked to encourage all bowlers missing out on selection to their team to apply for the draft so all centres have an opportunity to have a full team.

### **BALL CHECK**

Competitors will be restricted to a maximum of 6 balls (including sparing ball), which will have to be recorded on the official ball registration sheet and submitted to Tenpin SA prior to the commencement of the tournament. It is recommended that bowlers have their equipment checked prior to the Tournament. Random checks will be carried out during the competition by a TBA qualified ball driller.

## **VENUE & DATE**

The "SA Under 25's Challenge" will be conducted in a certified bowling centre on a date in November each year. The event will be held on a rotational basis at each competing centre.

## **CONTROL OF MATCHES**

The host Centre / Association will appoint the Tournament Director and he/she shall be in control of all tournament preparations and conduct of the matches while in progress.

He/she shall engage such assistance as may be deemed necessary for the successful conduct of the tournament.

## **CHALLENGE EVENTS**

- **Four player team:** Six games in two three game blocks. Each game will be bowled on a different pair of lanes, odds to the left one pair and evens to the right one pair. Total pinfall will determine the winner
- **Doubles:** Six games in one block. Each game to be bowled on a different pair of lanes, odds to the left one pair and evens to the right one pair. Total pinfall will determine the winner.
- **Singles:** Open to all members of each team, six games in one block. Each game will be played on a different pair of lanes, odds to the left one pair and evens to the right one pair. Total pinfall will determine the winner.
- **All Events:** The teams, doubles and singles pinfall will be used to calculate the All Event winners.
- **Masters:** Finalists will be the top 12 players (in each division) from the foregoing 18 games. (All events score). **Pin-fall will not be carried over.** Each bowler shall bowl 11 head to head matches (one match against each of the other finalists), total pins with a bonus of 10 points for each match won and 5 points for a draw, nil bonus points for a loss.
- Players failing to qualify for the masters shall fill vacancies which may exist at the start of the match play. Such vacancies shall be filled by non qualifiers in the order of finishing.
- Any masters finalists withdrawing for any reason after the finals commences shall be replaced by a pacer bowler where a pacer is used all players who play the pacer shall receive 5 bonus points.

## **TARDY PLAYERS**

Bowling will begin in accordance with a previously arranged schedule. Any player or team arriving late will begin play and scoring from the frame currently being bowled. If a team refuses to start because a full line-up is not present they will forfeit all games which they decline to bowl at the discretion of the Tournament Director. No blind scores will be permitted and a bowler must bowl, on the same lanes, and at the same time as his/her team bowls. A bowler who misses one frame or more by not being present and ready to bowl when it is his/her turn, will not be credited with any pins for any frames missed.

## **RESERVES**

Team reserves may be used for an injured bowler only. Points gained by the reserve will be counted towards the Team Score. Reserves are unable to qualify for Masters but are eligible to win a medal in any event that they compete. In the event that a team does not have a reserve bowler then the Emergency Rule will apply.

## **EMERGENCY RULE**

Once the tournament has commenced any bowler that withdraws from the event, for any reason other than injury, will be replaced by the Tournament Director who may select a suitable bowler to act as a pacer. No scores of the pacer shall be counted.

In the event of a player withdrawing at the last minute prior to the commencement of the tournament, the next available draft player is to be used to fill the vacancy created, or if there is no available draft players a player from the affected centre can be used as a replacement, providing all the other teams are agreeable.

## **DRESS RULE**

Dress rules will apply to this Tournament. All bowlers must wear a collared shirt. All men must wear dress slacks or dress shorts, no longer than 5cm above the knee and be of the same colour. Whilst slacks, dress shorts or skirts of the same length and colour will be acceptable for ladies teams

## **REGISTRATION**

The host centre will issue an invitation to all eligible centres in South Australia no later than 30 June each year  
Centres intending to participate must: complete and lodge the following forms with the host centre

- **10<sup>th</sup> September 2010 CENTRE / ASSOCIATION REGISTRATION**
- **30<sup>th</sup> September 2010 TEAM REGISTRATION (A deposit must accompany this form).**
- **11<sup>th</sup> October 2010 DRAFT REGISTRATION,(to be lodged with Dion Alexander  
email [sadevelopmentofficer@tenpin.org.au](mailto:sadevelopmentofficer@tenpin.org.au).)**
- **22<sup>nd</sup> October 2010 – Final participation fees to be paid (any un-financial team will not be able to bowl in the tournament)**

## **PARTICIPATION FEES:**

Each centre will pay the following fees, (based on 6 male and 6 female teams),

**Trophy Fund \$90**

**Tournament expenses \$20**

## **AWARDS**

At the completion of Singles, Doubles, Teams and All Events, Gold, Silver and Bronze medallions will be presented to the first 3 placings.

Masters: Gold, Silver and Bronze to the first 3 placing

In addition the SA Under 25's Challenge perpetual trophy will be awarded to the centre with the highest number of points gained in the four player teams, doubles, singles and all events. (refer to points table)

Sportsperson Award (male and female) will be voted on by the players

## **COACHING**

**Coaches only** will be allowed in the player's area as long as they do not impede players of the other team. Coaches must hold a current level 1 or higher TBA coaching accreditation, and hold a current registration card for the centre / association they represent, managers are not allowed in the players area regardless of whether the team has a coach or not.

## **CONTINGENCIES**

Any matters not covered in these rules and regulations will be decided by the Tournament Director.

## **POINTS TABLE**

The points score system for the SA Under 25's Challenge is based on the total number of bowlers in each division - if ten teams are competing, i.e.

**Singles/All Events:** 1<sup>st</sup> place 32 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> 31 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> 30 points, reducing by 1 down to last place 1 point,

**Doubles:** 1<sup>st</sup> place 64 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> 60 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> 56 points, reducing by 2 points down to last 4 points,

**Teams:** 1<sup>st</sup> place 128 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> 112 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> 96 points, reducing by 4 points down to last 16 points.

## Draft Player Policy



The Draft for the SA Under 25's Challenge is open to all bowlers who have completed the relevant Roll-off in the centre where they hold a current sports registration card but failed to make the Team.

### Objectives

- To provide a Centre / Association with a maximum of two bowlers to play in their relevant Centre / Association Team if their pool of players is depleted for any reason i.e. lack of numbers in competitors, etc.
- To provide players from Centres where there are many qualifiers an opportunity to compete in this tournament..

### Procedure

- Applicants must fill in the attached form providing scores and final standings of their own Centre / Association Roll-off as well as league averages and personal details. The applicant must also have their draft application form signed by an authorised member of their Centre / Association.
- All draft applicants must understand that if they are successful in the draft they must pay all expenses to the Centre / Association for whom they are competing as required.
- Applicants must have their coach if any liaise with the Coach of the Centre / Association Team for whom they are competing, so that they may be adequately prepared for the competition.
- During the actual competition, all successful drafted athletes must be part of that team and take directives from appointed Coaches and Managers.
- Applicants to be included in the draft must complete the application form and post to SA Under 25's Challenge Draft

### Draft Guidelines for Centre Associations and players

- Draft nomination forms are for circulation to all players who completed a selection or centre roll-off nomination form, but were not successful in their Centre / Association roll-off or did not gain selection for their centre.
- If more than two of any gender is required, application must be made to the Tenpin SA State Manager for approval.
- A Centre / Association Committee responsible for the selection of teams may call upon the Tenpin SA Draft to fill any team, providing the criteria defined in the Draft Guidelines are observed. Tenpin SA will keep a register of those bowlers who nominate for the Draft for a specific event. Once the closing date for those nominations has passed, Tenpin SA will offer Draft players to those Centre / Association Committees who have expressed an interest in procuring a player, based on the following procedure:
  1. Advise Tenpin SA that a Draft bowler is required
  2. The list of registered draft players is circulated to the centres requiring players, they are invited to select **one player** from that list.
  3. If the player turns down the invitation to play with a particular centre they are struck off the list and ineligible to participate in the Challenge Event
  4. A revised list is then passed on to the next centre in ascending order and the process is repeated until all draftees have been exhausted
- In the event that a Centre / Association Committee does not have a Roll-Off due to the required number of applicants being less than or equal to the bowlers required, then all applicants will be deemed to have been successful in the Roll Off and will therefore be ineligible to participate in the Draft process. In that case, any bowler who submits a nomination for their Centre / Association who then decides to not compete for their Centre / Association for any reason will not be eligible to participate in the event.
