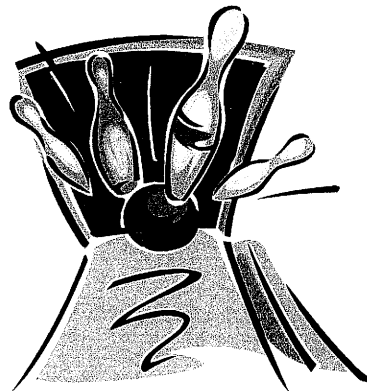

Rules and General Information

- THREE GAME SERIES:** In each grade, three games will be bowled by each entrant in the teams, doubles and singles events; the highest scratch three game series to win in each event.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all 2010 registered players of Tenpin Bowling Australia Ltd and who are in good standing and who have attained the age of 18 years on or prior to the first day of the championships. All bowlers will be required to present their 2010 TBA Registered Player Card, or receipt of payment, at check-in. Only 2010 TBA Registered Player Cardholders will be permitted to bowl. Cards will be available for purchase at check-in.
- CUT OFF DATE FOR ESTABLISHING AVERAGES:** Averages must have been established in a TBA league or accredited tournament, playing to a regular schedule, prior to midnight, 31st July 2010.
- WHICH AVERAGE TO USE:** Players are to use their highest current league or tournament average gained over a minimum of eighteen (18) games. If insufficient games have been bowled in the current league season, then the yearbook average as at the 31st December 2009 is to be used.
- BOWLERS WITHOUT AN AVERAGE:** A bowler who has no average over eighteen (18) games in accordance with Rules 4. and 5. must apply to the Tournament Director for average classification prior to submitting an entry. If no application is made then the entering average will be the minimum required for Open Grade. The Tournament Director has the right to re-grade any bowler or entry.
- PRIZE FUND:** All prize money contributed by the bowlers will be returned 100% on the basis of one prize for each 4 entries.
- REPLACEMENTS/CHANGES:** All replacements and changes to the original entry must be submitted to the Tournament Committee at least **15 minutes** before the time scheduled to bowl.
- ALL-EVENTS:** Mixed teams and mixed doubles scores do count towards all-events scores. A bowlers highest series in teams (or mixed teams), doubles (or mixed doubles) and singles will become their all events score in the grade of their entering average.
- MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION:** A bowler may have unlimited singles, doubles and teams entries. They may bowl with the same team and doubles partners.
- DRESS CODE:** Bowlers will be required to dress in suitable and presentable bowling attire, i.e. shirt with collar and dress trousers for men, shirt with collar and skirt or dress trousers/shorts for women.
- SPECIAL NOTE:** The Tournament Director, whose decision shall be final, will decide any matters that may arise and which are not covered by these rules.
- ENTRIES:** Entries can be sent to the Tournament Director, Tenpin Bowling Tasmania, PO Box 1188, Launceston 7250. Entries will be accepted on the day, subject to lane availability.

Masters – Open, Seniors & Restricted

State Open Masters

Qualifying: -

Qualifying can be completed up until the last available squad (9.30am) on the 29th August 2010. Qualifying series will be highest three (3) games singles or doubles attempt bowled during the championships, accompanied by a \$10.00 fee. Entry fee for qualifying outside of singles or doubles is \$30.00 and competitors are not permitted to qualify alone.

Finals: -

2009 State Masters Champions (male and female), plus current area champions and qualifiers (to a maximum of 10 bowlers) will go into the final. Finals will be over 10 games with the highest scratch pinfall to decide the winners. Winners will receive a suitably embossed shirt and the right to represent Tasmania in the 2010 AMF Australian Masters in Sydney. Prize payout will be one in eight.

FINAL: Sunday, 29th August at 11:00. (Check in 15 mins prior to starting). Cost of final: \$70.00.

Seniors Cup

Qualifying: -

***A Senior is defined as a bowler who must attain the age of 50 years or above in the year of the competition.*

Qualifying can be completed up until the last available squad (9.30am) on the 22nd August 2010. Qualifying series will be highest three (3) games singles or doubles attempt bowled during the championships, accompanied by a \$10.00 fee. Entry fee for qualifying outside of singles or doubles is \$30.00 and competitors are not permitted to qualify alone.

Finals: -

2009 Seniors Cup Champions (male and female) plus Qualifiers to make up a maximum of 6 finalists men and women. Finals will be over 6 games with the highest scratch pinfall to decide the winners. Winners will receive suitably embossed shirt and the right to represent Tasmania in the 2010 TBA Seniors Cup in Sydney. Prize payout will be one in eight.

FINAL: Sunday, 22nd August at 11:00am. (Check in 15 mins prior to starting). Cost of final: \$50.00.

Restricted Cup

Qualifying: -

***Restricted to bowlers with entering averages NOT exceeding 184 for men's division and 174 for women's division.*

Please note: Bowlers must provide proof of average for Restricted Cup by showing a copy of the standing sheet for each league they bowl in as at the 31st July 2010. Handicap event based on 100% of 200.

Qualifying can be completed up until the last available squad (9.30am) on the 22nd August 2010. Qualifying series will be highest three (3) games singles or doubles attempt bowled during the championships, accompanied by a \$10.00 fee. Entry fee for qualifying outside of singles or doubles is \$30.00 and competitors are not permitted to qualify alone.

Finals: -

2009 Restricted Cup Champions (male and female) plus current area Restricted Champions (if still eligible) and qualifiers will go into the finals (maximum 8 finalists). Finals will be handicapped (100% of 200) and will be over 8 games with the highest pinfall + handicap to decide the winners. Winners will receive suitably embossed shirt and the right to represent Tasmania in the 2010 TBA Restricted Cup in Sydney. Prize payout will be one in eight.

FINAL: Sunday, 22nd August 2010 at 11.00am. (Check in 15 mins prior to starting). Cost of final: \$60.00.
