RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. THREE GAME SERIES** will be bowled in each or any division by each entrant. Highest series to win in each case.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY** is open to all Tasmanian Junior TBA Registered bowlers (must NOT have had their 18th birthday by the 1st January 2010) who compete in a TBA registered centre.
- 3. ENTRIES** open from the 15th of January 2010 and will be taken on the day depending on lane availability. No refunds after entries close.
- 4. CUT OFF DATE FOR ESTABLISHING AVERAGES 31st December 2009.** Players are to use their highest league average over a minimum of 18 games as at 31st December. **NOTE. ALL BOWLERS MUST PRODUCE PROOF OF AVERAGES TO RECEIVE ANY PRIZES / MONEY.**
- 5. PRIZE MONEY.** Prize money subscribed as prize fund will be returned 100% on the basis of 1 in 8 entries.
- 6. BOWLERS WITHOUT AN AVERAGE** must apply to the Tournament Director for classification.
- 7. REPLACEMENTS** or changes to the original schedule must be reported to the Tournament Director at least 45 mins prior to the event starting. No refund will be given after this time elapses.
- 8. ALL EVENTS.** An All Events Champion will be declared for every grade contested. The bowler's average will determine their all events classification. The best appearances in Teams, Doubles and Singles will count towards all events regardless of the grade in which the Teams Doubles and Singles were bowled. No person will be listed more than once in the all events standing. **MIXED DOUBLES/MIXED TEAMS DO COUNT TOWARDS ALL EVENTS.**
- 9. MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION.** A team may bowl in their own grade and once in a higher grade. Open teams may bowl twice in their own grade. Any two bowlers from that team may form a new team and bowl again. **DOUBLES** Bowlers may have unlimited entries, but may only bowl twice with the same partner.
- 10. SPECIAL NOTE.** Any matters not covered by these rules will be decided by the Tournament Committee. **ALL T.B.A . RULES APPLY.**

OPEN MASTERS FINAL 2009 State Masters Champions plus current area champions (if still eligible) and qualifiers (to a maximum of 8 bowlers) will participate in the final. Final will be over 8 games with the highest scratch pinfall to decide the winners. Winners will receive a shirt and the right to represent Tasmania in the 2010 Australian Masters final.

RESTRICTED MASTERS This is a handicap event based on 100% of 200 for bowlers whose averages are 155 & under for boys and 145 & under for girls.

FINAL - 2009 State Restricted Masters Champions plus current area champions (if still eligible) and qualifiers (to a maximum of 6 bowlers) will participate in the final. Final will be over 6 games with the highest pinfall plus handicap to decide the winners.
