2011 TASMANIAN PRESIDENT'S SHIELD SELECTION TRIALS

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES – 20TH JUNE 2010

- 1) This tournament is open to all financial junior members of the TBA who have bowled a minimum of 24 games in a Registered Centre in a league during the twelve months prior to the tournament. League games completed as pre or post bowling do not count towards the number of games bowled. Bowlers must have taken up residence within the state prior to the closing of entries and must not have reached 18 years of age on the first day of January 2011.
- 2) Bowlers will be required to pay all costs involved, eg: airfares, accommodation, uniform, meals, bowling fees etc, depending on the solvency of the Junior Committee and fund raising efforts of local areas.
- 3) To be eligible to enter this tournament, bowlers must be of good standing and financial members of a TBA Licensed Association or Registered Bowling Centre in Tasmania and have submitted an ALL EVENTS entry in either State or Area/City Championships in the previous year or up until the departure of the state team.
- 4) There will be 14 games bowled in teams over the following 2 days :-

7 games	Moonah	Saturday 3 rd July 2010	***10.00am
7 games	Moonah	Sunday 4 th July 2010	9.00am

***Please note: all bowlers must check in with the Tournament director by 9.45am.
- 5) At the conclusion of 14 games, the top seven Boys & Girls with the highest total scratch pinfall will be declared the 2011 Tasmanian President's Shield team. In the event of a tie for seventh place, there will be a one game tiebreaker to decide the position.
- 6) No lay days will be permitted. All unforeseen circumstances to be submitted to the State Junior Committee for consideration.
- 7) Entry fee for the 14 games will be \$110 (payable to Tenpin Bowling Tasmania Inc.) and should be forwarded with your entry form to the Tournament Director – Garry Crick, PO Box 1188, Launceston Tas 7250. If a bowler wishes to compete and is eligible for both the President's Shield & Youth Teams Challenge Roll Offs, the total entry fee will be \$150.

Entries close Sunday 20th June 2010. All entries including completed parent declaration form & payment in full must be postmarked by midnight Friday 18th June 2010. No late entries will be accepted. If all conditions are not met, entries will not be accepted

8) **DRESS CODE:**

Bowlers must wear neat acceptable attire. No jeans, T Shirts, tank tops or hats are to be worn whilst competing. Bowling Sponsors attire may be permitted and at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

- 9) If not on file, your birth certificate will be requested to be sighted by the Tournament Director. Current TBA Registered Player Cards must be presented at check in.
- 10) Bowlers please note :- Any bowler found to be in breach of the TBA Anti Doping Policy will be subject to the penalties defined in this policy. Any bowler who is on ANY medication, prescribed or otherwise, must bring this fact to the attention of the Tournament Director.
- 11) Any bowler making the President's Shield Team **will** be required to attend all training sessions subject to the committee's discretion.
- 12) Any bowler making the President's Shield team **will** abide by the committee's Code Of Conduct.
- 13) Any bowler suspended from a bowling establishment may forfeit his or her place in the President's Shield Team subject to the decision of the Junior Committee.
- 14) The TBA Code Of Conduct applies to this event. Yellow & red cards will be issued for any of the following infractions :- equipment abuse, physical abuse, verbal abuse, obscene gestures, contravening the TBA Anti Doping Policy and contravening the TBA Code Of Ethics.
- 15) 1st payment of \$500 is to be paid by the 18th August 2010. A second payment of \$500 by the 14th November 2010 and the final balance by the 27th February 2011.

IF FULL PAYMENT IS NOT MADE BY THIS DATE, THE BOWLER CONCERNED WILL BE REPLACED IN THE TEAM.

- 16) Any matters not covered by these conditions will be decided by the Tournament Committee. All TBA rules and regulations will apply.

2011 YOUTH TEAMS CHALLENGE TEAM ROLL OFF ENTRY FORM

1. This tournament is open to all adult TBA Registered Players affiliated in Tasmania.
2. To be eligible for this tournament, participants must have bowled a minimum of 24 games in a League in a Registered Centre during the current year. League games completed as pre or post bowling do not count towards the number of games bowled.
3. Bowlers must be a financial member of a TBA Licensed Association or Registered Bowling Centre – in good standing and must not have reached 23 years of age on the 1st January 2011. Bowlers must have resided in Tasmania prior to the closing date of entries and must be a resident of Tasmania at the time of entries closing.
4. Entry Fee for the 14 games will be \$110 and should be forwarded with your entry form to the Tournament Director – Garry Crick, PO Box 1188, Launceston TAS 7250. If a bowler wishes to compete and is eligible for both the President's Shield & Youth Teams Challenge Roll Offs, the total entry fee will be \$150.

Entries close Sunday 20th June 2010 & must be post marked no later than Friday 18th June 2010.
Cheques which are to accompany entry forms are to be made payable to "Tenpin Bowling Tasmania Inc".

6. At the conclusion of 14 games, the top four men and top four women with the highest scratch pinfall will be the 2011 Tasmanian Youth Team. In the event of a tie for fourth place, there will be a one game play off to decide the position.
7. Any bad conduct or language will not be tolerated during the tournament. Warning cards: Yellow and red cards to be shown at the discretion of the Tournament Director. Red card will mean disqualification from the tournament.
8. Code of dress: Bowler's must wear neat acceptable attire. Men to preferably wear dress slacks, no shorts. Ladies may wear dress slacks, shorts, skirts or skorts. No jeans, track pants, T shirts, tank tops or hats are to be worn whilst competing.

NB: Any matters relating to this tournament and not covered by these rules will be decided by the State Adult Tournament Committee.

If I qualify, I agree, at the discretion of the abovementioned Committee to undergo a fitness check by a person or persons nominated by the Tenpin Bowling Tasmania Inc Adult Tournament Sub-Committee.

I further agree to abide by all directions given by the Tenpin Bowling Tasmania Inc Adult Tournament Sub-Committee including practice games, dates, venues and fundraising, appropriate fitness sessions or any other requirements set out by the committee.

CODE OF CONDUCT

IMPORTANT: YOU MUST READ AND UNDERSTAND:

All team members will agree to abide by the TBA Ltd national Code of Conduct.

All team members **Must** attend Compulsory Training Sessions and Tournaments prior to traveling to the national championships.

The TBA Ltd 'Drugs in Sport Policy' should be upheld at all times.

It is encouraged that team members should display an elite athlete lifestyle at all times. Behaviour must be at the highest level at all times. Swearing, Team confrontations in public, unacceptable social behaviour, childish pranks that could result in injury, and other acts, which can bring discredit to the Tasmanian Teams, will not be tolerated.

While traveling as a team, all leisure activities will be authorized by the Team Managers. Team members must understand that their commitment is to the Tasmanian Teams and the performance of the team as a whole. Social or leisure activities on an individual basis should NOT be organized without the prior approval of the Team Manager.

Team members must be well presented at all times. Personal or commercial advertisement, or any motivational or visual display and/or signage or sponsorship will not be displayed on Tasmanian Team uniforms and/or Tasmanian Practice shirts without the prior approval of the Tasmanian Rachuig/Youth Sub-Committee.

Bowlers must follow the directives given by the Team managers and Coaches at all times. The aims and objectives of the team as a whole will not be jeopardized through the acts of individual team members.

Failure by any team member to adhere to the Declaration and Code of Conduct Agreement may result in them being replaced in the team by the next available reserve or removal and departure from the team at their own expense.
