

NATIONAL TRAINING SQUAD HEAD COACH

JOB DESCRIPTION

Below outlines the position objectives, and key areas of responsibility that are associated with being a head coach of a National Training Squad in Tenpin Bowling Australia's High-Performance program.

KEY POSITION OBJECTIVES

The head coach is primarily responsible for working directly with athletes in their National Training Squad pool and their personal coaches to prepare for Asian Zone and World Championship events.

KEY AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY

The Head Coach is responsible for:

- Developing the training and tournament schedule for National Training Squad athletes;
- Assisting the TBA Performance Manager in the implementation of Individual Performance Plans for squad athletes;
- In conjunction with the TBA Performance Manager, assist in the development and planning of training camps for NTS athletes and National Teams;
- Developing strong relationships with athletes and their personal coaches;
- Contributing effectively as part of a team working towards the achievement of outcomes;

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES

Essential Requirements

- Silver Coaching accreditation with a minimum of 5 years of coaching elite-level athletes - please ensure you clearly identify the athletes you have worked with, time frame and the results the athletes have achieved in this time. Please provide url links of results for verification purposes. Please also state the state/territory teams you have worked with and all extra education modules completed.
- Organised, dynamic, professional coach with excellent oral and written communication skills
- Proven ability to work simultaneously on a wide range of projects, meet deadlines and work within set budgets.
- Manage feedback with interest, enthusiasm and professionalism
- Ability to contribute effectively as part of a team working towards the achievement of outcomes

Desirable

- Proven competency with video review technologies

COMPENSATION

- Whilst the position of Head Coach is a volunteer position the following assistance will be provided by TBA:
- Travel costs including airfares, accommodation and a per diem for meals for attendance at any international championship will be covered by TBA;
- Travel costs for attendance at training camps conducted throughout the year will be covered by TBA
